2 Minutes of last meeting held on Tuesday 30 May 2023 and Matters Arising.

The minutes were agreed as an accurate record.

3 Update from Country Park Guardian.

In Jon's absence there was no report.

4 Future Tasks and Events

John Wallace presented his report.

Putnoe Wood.

- Remove debris from brook, trim growth from banks and remove any low overhanging vegetation.
- Trim edges of the green path especially the eastern section.
- Obtain more MOT gravel from Jon Bishop to use at entrances and to fill hollows along paths.
- Tree surgeon is required to remove broken branch hanging close to eastern path.

Mowsbury Hillfort.

- Continue with butterfly survey.
- Continue golf ball collections. It was acknowledged that this is a difficult task now that the grass is high.
- Clean notice boards.
- Re-set right hand hanging post to large entrance gate to meadow.

Long term tasks in woods.

- Replace or repair bench at eastern end of central path.
- Repair or replace posts supporting handrails on timber bridge on southern border of wood.
- The spread of small balsam in the woods, especially to the south side, was noted. Small Balsam can be hand-picked along paths and in northern coppice plots, but as this now going to seed, use of slashers or brush cutters would be counter-productive.

John drew Friends' attention to the **CPRE Bedfordshire website** which gives details of a short wildlife and history walk around Mowsbury Hillfort and Putnoe Wood.

- **7.1.** Dave noted that there had been no follow up contact from Ravensden Parish Council following their expression of interest in erecting directional signs to the Hillfort.
- **7.2.** Martin noted that the First Aiders was still waiting for their certificates. He will write to Jon to enquire about this.
